A heart filled with aspirations is all that we knew since the very existence of the school and that's what gave us the ambition of marching forward even in this uncalled Pandemic, and we will march till excellence is achieved in all our endeavors. This report is comprised of the achievements made during the year gone by and at the same time set the path for greater accomplishments in the years to come.

SCHOOL GOES ONLINE:

Due to the Covid -19 the schools around the globe were shut down. In our state Chhattisgarh, the lockdown began from 18th March 2020. The management and the teachers never in their wildest dreams assumed such a drastic change in their routine. Everyone took to the lock down as a temporary situation, but in this temporary situation also we didn't want the students to suffer with their education an inch.

Keeping student's welfare in mind, the Management decided that the teachers start preparing Educational Videos for the students. It was totally a new idea and experience for all the teachers. But the teachers took this as a challenge and started preparing videos. The **very first** video was prepared on **18th March 2020**. The prepared videos were uploaded on the School's YouTube channel. The whatsapp groups of all the classes were made and it was made sure all the students were included in the group. The YouTube link of the videos were shared on the whatsapp groups. Teachers also shared pdfs of the notes for the benefit of the children.



We are very proud to have uploaded more than 400 videos during the month of March to May. The videos were not only related to their lessons, but also had of table mannerism, personality development, English and Hindi notable writers etc.

By July when the picture got clear that the schools won't open for some more months, a new challenge came in front of the management and the teachers, and the challenge was how to get connected with students. Then in the collaboration with Google Classroom the school decided to have online classes for all the grades.

The task started with making unique mail id of every student and every teacher. A full fledge training was given to the teachers about how they will be taking their online classes. A list of teachers were made who didn't had laptops/pc's. PC's were installed in such teacher's homes so as to be able to take online classes during the lockdown.

Great efforts were taken by the IT department of the school during this period. They made videos for the students, about how they can install Google Classrooms on their mobiles and how they will take their classes. It was a great challenge for the IT department to solve the queries and problems of the students, as it was a very new experience for the students too. **Wacom Tablets** were provided to the teachers especially the Maths and Science teachers for effective teaching. **The classes were meticulously planned with well-designed curriculum, interactive modules and structured timetables.**

ASSESSMENTS:

A new challenge in the form of how to take assessments came in front of the management and the teachers. The very first assessment was done with the help of Google forms and later the students were asked to make PDFs of their tests and mail it to the respective teachers. Here also the IT department was a great help not only for the teachers, but also for the students. They again made videos for teacher and students separately about how the assessments will be conducted.

PTA:

As a regular practice followed every year, in this session also the pandemic did not stop the teacher to give time to time progress of the student to the parents through the Parents-Teachers Meeting; PTM's were held for all the classes from Pre-Nursery to Class XII. The PTM's discussed not only the progress, but also the change in pattern of exam due to pandemic, results of online exam, change in syllabus etc.

CHATTISGARH PRIVATE SCHOOL FEE REGULATORY ACT:

This year the Chattisgarh Private School Fee Regulatory Act came into existence. The Act states that it wants every Private school to have a Fees Committee at school level. The school abides by the rule.

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENTS:

- a) The school library 'Aryavrat' is equipped with around 12,000 books that include Text books, subject reference books, periodical, daily newspaper, magazines etc. Special section for NEET, JEE, CLAT, UPSC, NTSE, KVPY preparation is available.
- b) The school also well-equipped Computer Labs with 40 computer each. Spacious and separate Labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths, where students can work in groups or individually.
- c) Music room, with musical instruments like table, harmonium, sitar, guitar, keyboard, violin, drums etc is available for the students.
- d) The school provides various sports facilities like football, cricket, athletics, basketball, volleyball, table tennis to the students. It also organizes compulsory Yoga and meditation facility to its students.

STAFF:

Holy Hearts is a school with total **96** well qualified teachers. The total number of **PGT's -15, TGT's-41, PRT's - 40** and **PRT's - 05** and also has **08** non-teaching staff.


CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM FOR TEACHERS:




CELEBRATIONS
